#### Studio Assignment

One of the key components of your enrollment is your studio assignment. At The Juilliard School, this assignment is driven by your expressed preferences, and with consideration for faculty availability.

You have been assigned to study with Mr. Richard Aaron. At this stage of the enrollment process, all studio assignments are tentative. Although we assume this assignment will be permanent, the school reserves the right to reassign you should unforeseen circumstances make the assigned faculty member unavailable.

**Scholarship and Financial Aid** A letter with information about scholarship and financial aid awards is generally available on your application status page <<http://apply.juilliard.edu/apply/status>> within 48 hours of receiving your offer of admission.

If you do not receive such notice, it may be because we are missing required financial aid materials. Please check your status page for any missing items and submit those items as soon as possible.

We encourage you to review the award letter once it is posted on your status page. Also on your status page, you will see a link to a video explaining how to read your award letter.

**Enrolling at Juilliard** You have until Saturday, May 1, 2021 to let Juilliard know your decision about where you will enroll in the fall. Your response, and a required \$250 deposit if enrolling, must be submitted online through your application status page <<https://apply.juilliard.edu/apply/status>>.

This offer of admission remains valid until your enrollment deadline.

This offer of admission is contingent upon the documented, successful completion of your current program of study (if applicable). We must have an official final transcript (with proof of graduation) by July 1, if not already submitted.

Official transcripts must be sent directly to Juilliard by your school. The transcript must state the diploma or degree earned, the date it was awarded, and the list of courses taken and grades earned throughout the course of study.

Note that if you accept the offer of admission, you also are accepting the offer of scholarship and financial aid, and are making a binding commitment to The Juilliard School. Should you wish to be released from this commitment, you must contact the Associate Dean for Enrollment Management, Kathleen Tesar, at [ktesar@juilliard.edu](mailto:ktesar@juilliard.edu).

It is your responsibility as an applicant to inform us of your decision by the deadline, if not earlier. If you are declining our offer of admission, your prompt notice will allow us to offer admission to someone on the waitlist.
